The school is focusing on Trainees and Young Investigators, however Young GI specialists wanting to join the network of future GI leaders are also very welcome. The aim of the school is the promotion of the best practice in the delivery of care in paediatric gastroenterology, focusing on most prevalent and serious as well as on more rare but equally important GI disorders.

Moreover, the delegates will have an option to take part and learn practical skills of endoscopy at endoscopy learning zone.
