

# ESPGHAN GI WINTER SCHOOL

It is a tradition of ESPGHAN to organise a Gastroenterologoy school every year. After a very successful event organised in Toulouse last June, we invite colleagues to join us for another very exciting school in the beautiful Bohinj in Slovenia.

The school is focusing on Trainees and Young Investigators, however Young GI specialists wanting to join the network of future GI leaders are also very welcome. The aim of the school is the promotion of the best practice in the delivery of care in paediatric gastroenterology, focusing on most prevalent and serious as well as on more rare but equally important GI disorders.

Moreover, the delegates will have an option to take part and learn practical skills of endoscopy at endoscopy learning zone. The school targets an audience of young medical professionals who either wish to develop or strengthen expertise and have an interest in the management of gastrointestinal disorders in children.

Combination of lectures, with time for a thorough discussion, presentation of interactive cases and hands-on activities will help participants in pursuing their aims.
